This utterly compelling and magical effort from Groth offers the splendid opulence of the 1985 Cask 23, the power and depth of the 1985 Heitz Martha's Vineyard, with the unsurpassed perfume and lavish richness of the 1985 and 1986 bottlings of Mouton-Rothschild. I scrutinized every aspect of this wine, finding everything in perfect harmony. The opaque ruby/purple color suggests awesome extract and low yields. The extraordinary bouquet of super-ripe and pure blackcurrants is enhanced by scents of toasty new oak, subtle mint, and violets. Sumptuous on the palate, with mind boggling richness, and brilliantly precise, well-focused, multi-dimensional flavors, this full-bodied wine is crammed with blackcurrant fruit that lingers on the palate for more than several minutes. Approachable now, the breathtaking wine should be at its apogee between 1992 and 2005. It is a tour de force in winemaking!
