VINTAGE

Harvest began on September 20th, it was a smooth and evenly paced, without as many heast spikes as we've seen in recent Napa Valley vintages. Milder weather meant we could pick more gradually, and it gave the grapes plenty of time to ripen and develop deep color and flavor. Continuing drought meant the vines struggled to access water, and the result was smaller clusters and berries yielding wines with intense flavors.

THE WINE

Blending: All the Cabernet from our Reserve Vineyard was harvested in 6 separate lots; portions of three were used for the final blend.

Merlot: 2%, grown on our Hillview Estate

Barrels: 100% new French oak

Aging: 22 months in barrel; 14 months

in bottle before release
