This October, we invite you to Sea Ranch for an intimate coastal weekend celebrating the release of our 2023 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon.

Introducing a new Reserve vintage along one of Northern California's most striking stretches of coastline is deeply intentional. It places the wine in a setting that reflects how it has always been meant to be experienced – unhurried, thoughtful, and shared among family and friends. There is also a natural connection at play: chert, a soil component central to the Reserve's character, was formed in the ocean hundreds of millions of years ago and carried inland over time, making the return to the coast a fitting place to introduce a new vintage.

The weekend will begin on Friday evening with a welcome dinner, setting the tone for the days ahead. Saturday will offer a coastal experience designed to reflect the natural beauty and rhythm of the North Coast, followed by a vertical library tasting of our Reserve, including the 2023, and a formal dinner. The pace throughout the weekend is designed to feel personal, immersive, and quietly memorable.

EXPERIENCE SEA RANCH

Sea Ranch holds a long and personal place in the Groth family story. Beginning in the 1970s, Dennis and Judy Groth returned to this rugged coastline as a way to step away from the pace of daily life and reconnect as a family. What began as summer stays with young children grew into decades of shared time – long walks along blustery trails, grandchildren discovering the shoreline, family meals that lingered late into the evening, and bottles of wine opened simply to be enjoyed together.

Over the years, Sea Ranch became less a getaway and more a constant: a place where cooking, conversation, and connection unfolded naturally. It is a setting shaped by respect for the land and a sense of quiet purpose, where architecture recedes into the landscape and time seems to slow. These qualities mirror the philosophy behind Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon and the life built around it.

EXPLORING THE RUGGED CALIFORNIA COAST

Set along a dramatic stretch of Sonoma County's northern coastline, Sea Ranch offers a striking blend of open meadow, windswept bluffs, and endless Pacific horizon. The landscape feels untouched and expansive, where cypress trees lean into the wind and waves carve patterns into rugged rock formations below. Miles of coastal trails trace the shoreline, inviting unhurried walks with nothing but the sound of the surf and seabirds overhead.

Just beyond Sea Ranch, the charm of Gualala offers galleries, small cafés, and sweeping views where the Gualala River meets the sea. A scenic drive north leads to the historic village of Mendocino, perched on headlands with Victorian architecture, quiet coves, and coastal gardens in bloom. Inland, redwood groves provide a peaceful contrast to the open coastline, their towering canopies offering cool shade and stillness.

Whether you're exploring tide pools, watching migrating whales in the distance, or simply taking in the ever-changing light along Highway 1, this stretch of the California coast encourages you to slow down and savor every view.

GETTING THERE

Reaching Sea Ranch is part of the adventure, and we encourage you to give yourself plenty of time for the drive. The final stretch along Highway 1 is stunning, with sweeping ocean views and winding coastal turns. If it is your first visit, we strongly recommend arriving in daylight so you can comfortably navigate the curves and fully take in the scenery.

From San Francisco, plan for approximately three hours, traveling north through Marin County before heading west toward the coast.

From Napa, allow about two and a half to three hours, heading north and then west as the landscape transitions

from vineyard lined valleys to forested hills and finally the Pacific shoreline.

From Sacramento, expect roughly three and a half to four hours. You will travel west toward the Bay Area before turning north and eventually west to meet the coast.

Wherever you begin, fuel up in advance, as services are more limited along the shoreline. Take your time, pause at a scenic overlook if the view calls to you, and let the journey ease you into the slower rhythm of the coast.

May I bring additional guests?

Each “Reserve by the Sea” package is designed for two guests and includes a two night stay at Sea Ranch Lodge, along with access for both of you to the full weekend experience. This includes Friday’s welcome dinner, Saturday’s Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon vertical tasting, lunch, and our winemaker dinner overlooking the sea, as well as breakfast each morning.

Additional guests are welcome to join, though a separate package must be purchased for each pair of attendees.

A very small number of rooms offer two queen beds and may accommodate additional guests. If you choose to include others in one of these rooms, an additional per person fee will apply. For details and availability, we invite you to connect with our team directly.

Are children allowed?

Children are welcome to join you at Sea Ranch Lodge. Please note, however, that the Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon vertical tasting is reserved for guests 21 and over.

If you are considering bringing children, we kindly ask that you reach out to our team in advance to discuss details, pricing, and availability so we can help you plan accordingly.

Are pets allowed?

Select guest rooms on the ground floor are dog friendly with a \$250 refundable deposit and \$50 nightly fee. Guests need to provide advance notice if they are traveling with a dog.

Can I extend my stay?

If you would like to extend your time at Sea Ranch Lodge, we encourage you to contact the lodge directly to inquire about availability and to make arrangements for any additional nights.

When is check in and check out?

Check-in is at 4pm and check-out is at 12pm, noon.
