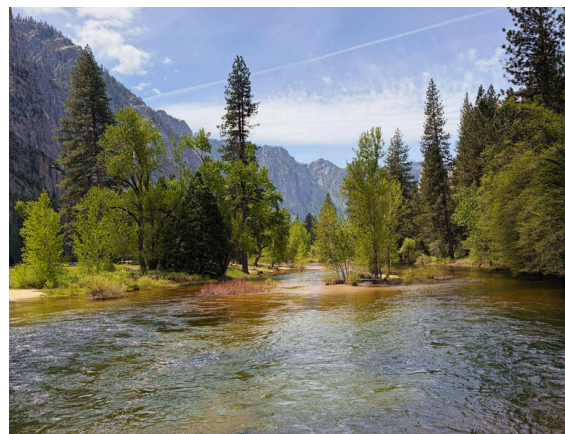

Pet Policy

Guests traveling with a dog must confirm that their selected accommodation is dog-friendly. Additional pet fees may apply depending on the property. Dogs must remain under owner supervision and on a leash no longer than six feet, and may not be left unattended in accommodations or anywhere on the property. Guests must clean up after their dogs and properly dispose of all waste. Noisy, vicious, or unruly dogs are not permitted. Owners are responsible for any injury, damage, repair, or replacement costs caused by their dog.

Quiet Hours

Autocamp observes quiet hours between 10:00 pm and 8:00 am daily to ensure the comfort of all guests. All individuals agree to respect quiet hours. Should Autocamp receive noise complaints a fee of \$500 may be assessed, for multiple complaints, the individual may be asked to leave the premises.

Decorations

No displays, exhibits, banners, decorations, etc. may be attached to walls, doors, or structures without the consent of the Autocamp property. Failure to comply to this may result in a \$500+ cleaning/repair fee and immediate removal of the individual from the premises.
